APPENDIX 2

Orders for the Commencement and Cessation of Firing

Commencement of firing

One blast will be sounded on the sirens in NSC Office, unless otherwise ordered, as a signal that firing may commence.

General signal to cease fire

- 1. The sounding of two blasts at an interval of about 15 seconds, is an order to "Cease Fire" at any moment during the day and must be obeyed at once, and all firearms unloaded.
- 2. The general signal to cease fire will be given daily as soon as all firing has been completed.

WARNING

It is prohibited to cross any of the ranges at any time during the hours of shooting.

APPENDIX 4

Instructions to Officials

1. When on duty on the Ranges —

The NRA Officers and Staff will wear the Blue NRA Staff Badge.

The Chief Range Officers will wear an arm-band lettered CRO.

Competitor Wing Officers supervising more than one Range will wear blue "high visibility" jackets labelled "WING OFFR".

NRA Range Conducting Officers and Butt Officers (i.e. those in charge of one Range or Butt) will wear red "high visibility" jackets labelled "NRA RCO".

Competitor Range Conducting Officers will wear yellow "high visibility" jackets labelled "NRA RO" or "NRA ARO".

NRA temporary staff will wear white identification.

2. The following Code Messages should be used for communication between Range Conducting Officers and the Butts. The target number will be given, followed by the message number, viz:

Message Message	1 2	Firing about to commence. No spotting disc visible.
Message	3	Spotting disc unmistakably disagrees with signalled value. Check that spotting disc shows LAST shot and signals its correct value* (Para. 201). The Range Conducting Officer is to view the target before passing the message.
Message	4	A shot has been fired but no signal has been made. Examine target carefully and signal the shot if found or a miss* (Para. 203).
Message	5	Firer has challenged for a higher value for his shot. Examine the whole target and signal the correct value* (Para. 205).
Message	6	Radio the number of hits as Score Board figures are not clear. (SR & Cadets only)
Message	7	A miss has been signalled but firer has challenged for a scoring shot. Re-examine the target carefully and signal the shot if found or a miss* (Para. 204).
Message	8	Firer has challenged his score. Re-examine the target and show the correct number and value of the shots* (Para. 213).
Message	9	Marking/shooting appears to be unduly slow. Butt□/□Range Conducting Officer to check and correct where necessary.
Message	10	Stand easy. Half-mast target.
Message	11	It is suspected that the wrong shot hole has been patched out. Butt Officer is to consult marker and confirm correct value.* †.
Message	12	Stand easy. Lower target, patch out and put target back up.
Message	13	Blow off shots are about to be fired (MR□only). Ensure that all targets are fully lowered until Message 1 is given.
Message	14	It is suspected that there is a second shot on the target: inspect the target and indicate any further shot found in addition to the shot presently shown.*
