2017 IMPERIAL MEETING ENTRY FORM NOTES

Please read through these notes carefully before filling in the entry form.

Once you have completed this entry form please separate the two sections carefully along the perforations, return the entry form portion and keep these Notes for future reference. If you have any difficulties in completing this form please contact the Squadding Department for help.

1 Entering the Imperial Meeting

It is easier and costs less for you to enter the Imperial Meeting online at www.nra.org.uk rather than complete this paper entry form. In addition, entering via the website is much quicker, more accurate and more secure than a paper entry form and your entry fees and discounts will be correctly calculated automatically. You are therefore encouraged to use this paper form only for reference, and to make your entry and pay securely online. A printed receipt will be posted to you in the normal way.

2 TRID Number

In order to match up your scores from previous Imperial Meetings, we have introduced the concept of a TRID - a number that will remain unchanged and unique to the individual. You can see your TRID as these are now shown alongside your name when you do a search on the website for scores at <http://scores.nra.org.uk>. If you have competed in a previous Imperial Meeting since 1999 you will need to look up your TRID as it will be a required field in both the online entry and the paper form. If you do not have web access or this is your first Imperial Meeting please leave this field blank; alternatively contact the Squadding Department for help.

3 Completion of Entry Form

The price of each TR squadded competition includes ammunition and marker fees. The price of MR and F Class squadded competitions does not include ammunition.

Please ensure that all details are completed carefully and legibly. Please use your TRID wherever possible so we do not duplicate entries in the Class lists or team records. If you are paying by credit card we must have your full billing address including postcode.

Please ensure that you complete all boxes in the top section of the form as these details are essential for the computer system. You may insert up to two Clubs, Primary (which will be the one shown on all prize lists) and Secondary (for use by captains in team selection). You should also state for which County and for which Country you are eligible to shoot. You must enter your date of birth in the box shown so that the correct entry fees can be calculated and you must sign the Certificate. Failure to do so may require the return of your entry form for correction.

4 Classification of Competitors

Target Rifle Competitions	
X	Those whose names were published as Class X in the 2016 Prize List.
A	Those whose names were published as Class A in the 2016 Prize List.
O	One who is not a Class X, Class A or Class T.
T	One whose name has never appeared in any open prize list relating to a TR competition included on this entry form above "Last O In" (but see Rule 718b).
F	All competitors using F Class rifles (Rule 164).
Note	Classes of overseas competitors must be certified in accordance with Appendix XVI of the Bisley Bible. Class T status may not be claimed by adult overseas competitors.

In addition to entering your GB TR Class and (where applicable) MR Class, overseas competitors only should also insert their National Classification in their own country.

5 Record of Rifles Used

GB competitors must record all details of the rifle(s) to be used during the Meeting as required by the Firearms (Amendment) Acts 1997. Please insert the type and serial number of the rifle(s) to be used. If necessary, please make an appropriate note and continue on a separate sheet. It is in your interests to record the use of all your firearms.

If you are under the age of 19 and are shooting the TR events of the Imperial Meeting with an issued L81A2 Cadet Target Rifle, please tick the relevant box on this entry form.

6 Muzzle Energy

The MoD now requires that all firearms used on its ranges (and this includes Bisley since we use the Pirbright Range Danger Area) must either have a muzzle energy under 4,500 Joules (3,319 ft lbs) or else be zeroed at 200 yards or on the Bisley Zero Range prior to being used at a longer distance. This does not affect TR, but may affect MR, F Class or Sporting Rifle. If your ME exceeds the limit then you must zero your rifle, using the specially designed target, the day before the start of your particular Meeting. A qualified RCO (HME) will be in attendance on the NRA Zero Range.

7 F Class Competitions

F Class includes two subdivisions, defined in Para 164. In both F (Open) and F/TR, the trigger pull may be unlimited but must be safe. The rifle may be fired from the prone position only. Telescopic sights may be used. A rear butt support is allowed. Sound moderators are permitted but muzzle brakes are prohibited. In F/TR the rifle must be in .308 Win or .223 Win calibre and conform to CIP dimensions. A bipod may be attached and a sling may be used. Maximum weight is 8.25kg including all attachments other than the sling. In F (Open), calibres up to 8mm may be used. The rifle may weigh up to 10kg. A fore-end rest may be used or a bipod may be attached. A sling may be used.

F (Open) and F/TR competitors may either supply their own handloaded ammunition or purchase commercially available ammunition, including GGG which will be available only from the Range Office. All handloaded ammunition must comply with NRA Range Safety Regulations and conform to CIP standards.

The Century Range, Stickledown Range, Donaldson Memorial (including a Final which will be held on Second Monday) and the 2009 FCWC Celebration Aggregates and the Grand Aggregate are the only aggregates open to F Class; sweeps are not open to F Class. There will be an F Class Final in both The Farquharson (at 1000 yards on Second Tuesday) and the St George's (at 900 yards on Second Tuesday) for the top eight competitors in each First Stage for both F (Open) and F/TR. Full details are published in the Bisley Bible.

8 Match Rifle Competitions

All competitors firing in the Match Rifle Meeting must supply their own ammunition. Those who are firing TR may use any ammunition, including handloads, but those wishing to compete in the GGG Aggregate must use the GGG ammunition bought from the Range Office.

9 Shooters Certification Card (SCC)

Competitors at the Imperial Meeting may only collect their squadding cards on production of their SCC. Squadding cards will not be issued without one. In the case of overseas competitors the relevant certificate must have been signed by their own National Governing Body (please see the article on the NRA website for fuller details).

10 Concessions/Discounts/Cancellation Fee

Competitors who, on the last day of the Meeting, are under 25 years of age, may reduce their entry fees by 40% (except for sweeps).

Cancellation of all matches after squadding (7 days prior to the start of the MR Meeting) will incur a 10% cancellation fee.

11 Membership of the NRA

Full NRA or Meeting Membership is a compulsory requirement for entry to any competition on this form. If you are not a current full member of the NRA please fill in the Meeting Membership box and pay the appropriate fee. If you would like to join the NRA as a full member please include a note to this effect and we will send you a membership pack.

Meeting Membership Rates

- £58 Entering TR, MR or F Class events and not eligible for concessions
- £23 Under 21, or Under 25 and undergoing full-time education
- Free Under 21, or Under 25 and undergoing full-time education, and entering the Meeting for the first time.
- £15 If entering HM The Queen's Prize (1st Stage) ONLY or The Farquharson (1st Stage) ONLY, special reduced fee applies.

12 Chairman's Prize

The Chairman's Prize now has a separate Final on the morning of Second Friday open to the top 50 in each of Class O and T in the Grand Aggregate. The Final will be a Queen's III course of fire. Full details can be found in the Bisley Bible.

13 Shooting Mentors (Aunts and Uncles) Scheme

Any competitor, particularly those entering for the first time, who would like to be mentored by an "Aunt" or "Uncle" (an experienced competitor who can help and advise you and assist with any shooting problems) should complete the appropriate box on the entry form. You will then be contacted in due course with further details.

Any suitably experienced competitors who would like to volunteer to be a mentor should contact the Squadding Department.

14 Special Duties

All competitors under 70 years of age are liable for special duties unless exemption, supported by a current Doctor's certificate, is claimed. Competitors required to perform Special Duties will be expected to carry them out, since they are not transferable. If you are over 70 but would like Special Duties please include a note to this effect,

15 Requests for Special Squadding

Requests from competitors for special squadding (eg the same detail or different details from that of another competitor) will only be processed if considered reasonable and must be received before 1 July.

16 Overseas Competitors

Applications for Visitors Firearms Permits should be made no later than 1 May 2017, and much earlier if possible. Applications made after this date may not be processed in time for the Imperial Meeting. Please use the VFP application form available as a download on the NRA website. Competitors from within the EC **must include a valid European Firearms Pass where applicable, a copy is acceptable.**

17 OTF Swindles (Queen's and Albert)

The annual OTF Swindle (concurrent with Queen's I) provides valuable support to all GB and NRA teams travelling overseas including TR, U25, MR and F Class. Entries are allocated randomly to teams of ten with similar proportions of each class (X, A, O and T). Multiple entries are encouraged and increase your chances of winning team or individual prizes totalling £1,200.

The Match Rifle Swindle for Match Rifle shooters uses a similar formula to the Queen's I Swindle (above) but is for teams of four. Entries are allocated randomly and multiple entries are encouraged. There are cash prizes for the first and second teams and also for the lowest placed team.

18 Early Entry Draw

19 Early Entry Discount

Entries received before 1 June 2017 Deduct 10% of entry fee

Entries will not be accepted for any match after 12 noon on the day preceding the match.

20 Credit Card Payment

If you make a paper entry using this form you may pay by credit / debit card, or by cheque.

If paying by credit card the name and address of the cardholder must be that of the competitor making the entry. Please make sure that your full address and postcode are entered correctly as we need this information to process credit card entries. If you wish to include payment for other members of your family, please add up the relevant amounts and insert that total in the space on the cardholder's entry form only. The three digit security number required is the last three digits of the number on the signature strip on the back of credit card and must be emailed separately to info@nra.org.uk (required before entry can be processed).

21 Return of Receipts

A receipt will be returned to you by email/post shortly after your entry has been entered in the computer. This receipt will state what information we hold about you and what entries you have made. Your Bisley Bible (if ordered) may be collected at registration. If any of the information on the printout is incorrect or you have omitted to complete a section of the form you should inform the Squadding Department so that the changes can be made before the Imperial Meeting commences.

Please note that you must produce the receipt and your SCC in order to obtain your computer labels and squadding details at Bisley (available from 14:00 on Thursday 6 July 2017).

22 Prize Lists

All prize lists will be produced in CD and book format. A free Prize List CD will be sent to all competitors in the Grand Aggregate or the Hopton Match Rifle Aggregate, providing that they request one on this entry form, otherwise the cost is £5.50. A printed book may be ordered by competitors and Club Secretaries at a cost of £20. Please note that if the Prize List CD box is left blank we will assume you do **not** wish to receive one.

23 Medals and Bars

All competitors are required to complete the appropriate box on the entry form if they wish their medals and bars to be sent to them. Please note that if the Medals and Bars box is left blank we will assume you do not wish to receive them.

24 Entry to other Competitions

There are many other competitions which are not included on this entry form, and these are classified as:

- a individual squadded shoots;
- b prizes reserved for ladies, overseas competitors, cadets and other categories;
- c team aggregates.

Entry forms for these competitions will be available for download from the website. Entries must be made at the Front Counter in the NRA Offices. Please do not try to enter these competitions before the Imperial Meeting.
