**RANGE REGULATIONS FOR WINANS NON STANDARD NO DANGER AREA RANGE**

<b>THE RANGE</b>	
<b>Name</b>	Winans Non Standard No Danger Area Range
<b>Description</b>	Winans Range is a 25m open non-standard No Danger Area Range Complex consisting of 3 bays.  There are specific restrictions and permissions for each bay detailed below
<b>BAY C (Zero Range) – WINANS RANGE 71’ 7” Open Non-Standard NDA Range</b>	
<b>FIREARMS AND AMMUNITION</b>	
<b>Firearms and ammunition that may be fired on the range including ME &amp; MV</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Only full bore rifles are permitted: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. A maximum muzzle velocity of 1000 m/s (3280 ft/s)</li> <li>b. A maximum muzzle energy of 7000J (5160 ft lb)</li> </ol> </li> </ol> <p><b>Note - .22 and .17 HMR are not permitted to be fired on Winans Range</b></p> <p><b>Ammunition</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>2. Rifles - all natures included within Bisley Range Regulations.</li> </ol>
<b>RANGE SAFETY LIMITATIONS</b>	
<b>Coordinating Instructions</b>	<p><b><u>Winans Range Bay C (Zero Range) may be used under self supervision as permitted in Bisley Range Regulations.</u></b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. NRA policy on eye protection applies.</li> <li>2. Hearing protection is mandatory for all persons within the confines of the range.</li> <li>3. The Zero Range is not to be used as a training/testing facility members are allocated a period of 20 mins in which to zero their firearm.</li> </ol> <p><b><u>Rifles</u></b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>4. Winans Bay C is marked with 4 x firing points and 4 x corresponding target locations.</li> <li>5. Targets are to be placed in softwood frames in the holders located on the face of the canopy lower wall.</li> <li>6. All permitted types of rifle and firing position may be mixed between firers on any single detail or practice.</li> <li>7. Supported deliberate fire only.</li> </ol>
<b>Firing Positions</b>	Prone and Supine only from the marked firing points at corresponding targets.
<b>Targetry</b>	Only Zeroing targets purchased from, or provided by, the Range

	Office may be used on this range.
<b>ACCIDENT/INCIDENT PROCEDURES</b>	
<b>Special Safety Instructions</b>	As per the NRA Range Action Safety Plan which will be initiated by the Range Office on notification of a major incident/accident.
