FIREARMS AND AMMUNITION	
Firearms and ammunition that may be fired on the range including ME & MV	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Gallery rifles and pistols; <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. A maximum muzzle velocity of 655 m/s (2150 ft/s) b. A maximum muzzle energy of 2030 J (1496 ft lb) <p>Note - .22 Hornet and .17 HMR are not permitted to be fired on Cheylesmore range</p>
RANGE SAFETY LIMITATIONS	
Coordinating Instructions	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Range infrastructure is not to be used as targetry or to zero/check zero firearms. 2. Changes of position are not permitted within any detail or practise. 3. There is to be no movement forward of the firing point 4. Targets are only to engaged at 25m 5. Targets are not to be engaged whilst moving.
Firing Positions	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Firing is to be carried out from the benched position only. 2. Firing is only permitted from the 25m firing point there is to be no movement forward of the firing point.
Targetry	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Only targets from the NRA approved set, attached to the Overhead Retrievable Targets, may be engaged. 2. Targets are to be used in the frames or holders provided.

Special Safety Instructions	As per the NRA Range Action Safety Plan which will be initiated by the Range Office on notification of a major incident/accident
