RANGE REGULATIONS FOR CENTURY GALLERY RANGE

THE RANGE	
Name	Century Gallery Range
Description	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Century range is a 100 - 600yd Gallery range consisting of 128 target lanes, divided into 10 Butts, 1 of 12 target lanes and 9 of 12 target lanes. 2. Butt 10 consists of 20 lanes with primary use going to the 300m Shed. Lanes 1 – 8 in Butt 10 are 300m Shed Kongsberg electronic targets. McQueens Castles can be fitted on Butt 10 Lanes 11/12, 14/15. 3. Butt 11-19 inclusive consists of 12 x targets. McQueens Castles can be fitted on Lanes 70, 72 in Butt 16 and Lanes 85, 87, 89 in Butt 18. 4. Excepting specific events 100 yds can only be shot on Butts 18 & 19. Butt 19 Targets 103 – 108 inclusive are NRA Kongsberg electronic targets. 5. Maximum permitted elevation (QE) is 70mils (4°).
FIREARMS AND AMMUNITION	
Firearms and ammunition that may be fired on the range including ME & MV	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Rifles, gallery rifles, shotguns and pistols by special arrangement only: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. A maximum muzzle velocity of 1000 m/s (3280 ft/s) b. A maximum muzzle energy of 4500 J (3319 ft lb) c. Firearms 4500J – 7000J HME procedures apply
RANGE SAFETY LIMITATIONS	
Coordinating Instructions	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Vehicles are not permitted on the Range Floor without prior permission from the Range Office. 2. The Butts are to be accessed by the Markers walkway or Hobsons Way 3. If the NRA does not have priority, shooting is not permitted on Butts 10-13 inclusive. 4. If THE NRA has priority but the NCSC or BGC are operating all areas forward of the 300yd point in Butts 10-13 are out of bounds. 5. If the 300m shed is in use the following restrictions apply: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. 300yd shooting is permitted from target 1 b. 400yds shooting is not permitted below (left of) Target 8 c. 500yds shooting is not permitted below (left of) Target 13

	<p>d. 600yds shooting is not permitted below (left of) Target 21</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 6. Firing positions on target lanes 85-108 at 400yds, inclusive, are restricted to sitting, kneeling and standing, no prone shooting is permitted. 7. Courses of fire that involve movement (other than changing firing position eg from standing to kneeling) with a loaded firearm are forbidden except with prior authority of the CE. No fire with movement is permitted in Butts 18 & 19. 8. All firers must access and egress from the 600yd firing point of the appropriate Butt unless prior permission granted by the Range Safety Supervisor. 9. 600yds shooting is not permitted on lane 108. 10. The pedestrian gate from Short Siberia car park must be closed and a safety board deployed if shooting is from a distance greater than 100yds in Butts 18 or 19. 11. The 300m Shed gate must be closed and locked if shooting is from a distance greater than 300m in Butts 10, 11 or 12 12. The 300x gate on the right hand side must be closed if shooting is from a distance greater than 300x in Butt 19. 13. The 500yd gate must be closed and locked if there is shooting from 600yds in Butts 11, 12 or 13.
<p>Firing Positions</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. All shooting is to be conducted from the left of pegs. 2. Shooting is to be carried out from the prone or supine position, or from a bench except where expressly provided by the conditions of a particular discipline or approved competition rules. 3. Permission to fire from any other position must be granted by the Range Office and notified in the booking request in order to allow suitable target allocation on the range.
<p>Targetry</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Unless prior permission has been obtained from the CE only targets from the NRA approved set may be used. 2. Targets are to be used in the frames or holders provided and are to be engaged only from the recognised firing points and appropriate shooting station or peg. 3. Snap targets are to be exposed in or in front of target frames. 4. No laterally-moving target may be used on gallery ranges.
