**RANGE STANDING REGULATIONS FOR CHEYLESMORE RANGE – BAY B**

<b>THE RANGE</b>	
<b>Name</b>	Cheylesmore Non Standard No Danger Area Range
<b>Description</b>	<p>Cheylesmore Range has a total of 3x 25m bays.</p> <p>Bay A contains 2 x banks of ISSF targets</p> <p>Bay B contains 20 x turning targets in 4 x banks of 5</p> <p>Bay C contains 2 x Overhead Retrievable Targets (ORT)</p>
<b>CHEYLESMORE – BAY B</b>	
<b>FIREARMS AND AMMUNITION</b>	
<b>Firearms and ammunition that may be fired on the range including ME &amp; MV</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Gallery rifles and pistols;               <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. A maximum muzzle velocity of 655 m/s (2150 ft/s)</li> <li>b. A maximum muzzle energy of 2030 J (1496 ft lb)</li> </ol> </li> </ol> <p><b>Note</b> - .22 Hornet and .17 HMR are not permitted to be fired on Cheylesmore range</p>
<b>RANGE SAFETY LIMITATIONS</b>	
<b>Coordinating Instructions</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Range infrastructure is not to be used as targetry or to zero/check zero firearms.</li> <li>2. Changes of position are permitted within any detail or practise providing all firers follow the same sequence.</li> <li>3. Fire and movement is not permitted on Cheylesmore Range.</li> <li>4. A Suitably Qualified Experienced Person (SQEP) is to be appointed as the responsible RO is mandatory when shooting on Bay B.</li> <li>5. The shutter between Bay A &amp; B is to be lowered when Bay A is in use.</li> </ol>
<b>Firing Positions</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Firing is to be carried out from the standing, kneeling, benched position, except where expressly provided by the conditions of a particular discipline or approved competition rules. The intention to fire from any other position must be notified to the Range Office at the time of booking to allow suitable target allocation on the range.</li> <li>2. Firing is permitted forward of the 25m firing point to a minimum engagement distance of 10m.</li> </ol>
<b>Targetry</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Unless prior permission has been obtained from the CE only targets from the NRA approved set may be used.</li> <li>2. Targets are to be used in the frames or holders provided and are to be engaged only from the recognised firing points</li> <li>3. Skittles, falling plates or other hard targets may not be engaged within Cheylesmore Range</li> </ol>

	4. Clay pigeons are not to be engaged within Cheylesmore Range
<b>ACCIDENT/INCIDENT PROCEDURES</b>	
<b>Special Safety Instructions</b>	As per the NRA Range Action Safety Plan which will be initiated by the Range Office on notification of a major incident/accident.
