

Chairman of the Association

Members of General Council held a Special Meeting on Saturday 8th February 2014 to consider the background to the recent resignation of Dr Robin Pizer as Chairman of the Association.

The meeting was attended by Dr Pizer and the NRA Trustees; commenced at 11.00am and was concluded at 3.45pm.

Members of General Council recognised that both Dr Robin Pizer and the Association's Trustees had received a fair and impartial hearing at the meeting; and voted to accept the resignation of Dr Robin Pizer as Chairman of the Association (28 in favour, 4 against, 2 abstentions).

Members of General Council recognised Dr Pizer had achieved a great deal for the Association during the five years he served as Chairman. Significant restructuring has transformed the finances of the Association from losses of £576k in 2010 to a forecast surplus of over £300k in 2013. Members expressed their gratitude for his contributions in delivering this improvement in financial performance which, coupled with growing membership, will be part of Dr Pizer's legacy of his time as Chairman.
