GALLERY RIFLE SKILLS DEVELOPMENT COURSE – SUNDAY 5 NOVEMBER 2017

AIM

The Gallery Rifle (GR) Skills Development Course will provide the fundamental skills for taking part in GR events and competitions, and will include individual coaching of positional shooting techniques. The course is open to all NRA members including those who do not currently hold an FAC or possess the appropriate firearm, but have successfully completed the required probationary course. Non-NRA members can attend providing they possess the appropriate firearm and pay the additional membership fee.

The course will involve both classroom and practical range work with expert coaching from national and international level shooters.

COURSE FEE

The course fee is £71.50, which includes range fees, targets, scorebook, individual coaching and lunch. Ammunition and firearms are not included and attendees are expected to arrange, or bring their own.

Those wanting to loan a rifle, tick the box on the attached form.

DRESS AND EQUIPMENT

Attendees should bring warm and weatherproof clothing and appropriate footwear in case of inclement weather. You will need:

- Ear defenders
- Firearm
- Approximately 500 rds .22 rimfire and/or 200 rds centrefire ammunition
- Normal shooting equipment
- Notebook and pencil

Tea and coffee will be available during the classroom sessions and lunch will be in Canada House (building 27 on the map) on Bisley Camp – at no extra charge.
