## **NRA INTRODUCTION TO TARGET RIFLE COURSE** **Saturday 24 February 2018**

### **AIM**

The Introduction to Target Rifle (TR) course will provide those who have little or no experience of shooting TR with the fundamental skills to enable them to shoot TR competently with others at their clubs. The course will include individual coaching on shooting position and technique, adjusting the sights, zeroing the rifle and using score sheets. The course is open to all NRA members who have a Shooter Certification Card (SCC) for Iron Sighted Rifle, including those who do not currently hold an FAC or possess a Target Rifle. Non NRA members can attend providing they possess a suitable Target Rifle and pay the additional membership fee.

This is a one day course and will involve both classroom and practical range work.

This course is being run in conjunction with the Bisley clubs and the location for the course will be the Webley Room, NRA Pavilion on Bisley Camp.

### **COURSE FEE**

The course fee is £73.50 (£44.10 for Under 25s) which includes individual coaching, range fees, markers, plotting sheets, shooting equipment if required (jacket, sling, glove) and lunch.

Ammunition and rifles are not included and attendees are expected to bring their own. Upon production of their membership card, NRA members not yet in possession of a suitable target rifle can hire one for £17.50 for the day (50% discount), and purchase ammunition (24 rds of 7.62mm at a cost of £19.68) which will be issued on range.

### **CANCELLATION FEE**

Courses cancelled within 5 working days of course date will be subject to a cancellation fee of £20.00.

### **DRESS AND EQUIPMENT**

Attendees should wear their usual shooting clothing, with under layers according to the weather. Footwear suitable for soggy ranges and waterproof trousers and jackets should also be brought. Attendees should bring any shooting gear appropriate to TR that they have or usually borrow (e.g. from their club), including shooting jacket, sling, glove, hat and ear defenders. All these items (except hats) will be provided if you don't have them. If you possess your own Target Rifle or can borrow and bring the one that you usually use with your club, you should bring it with you.

### **FOOD AND BEVERAGE**

Tea and coffee will be available during the classroom sessions of the course at no extra charge. Lunch will be provided in one of the Bisley Clubs.

### **ACCOMMODATION**

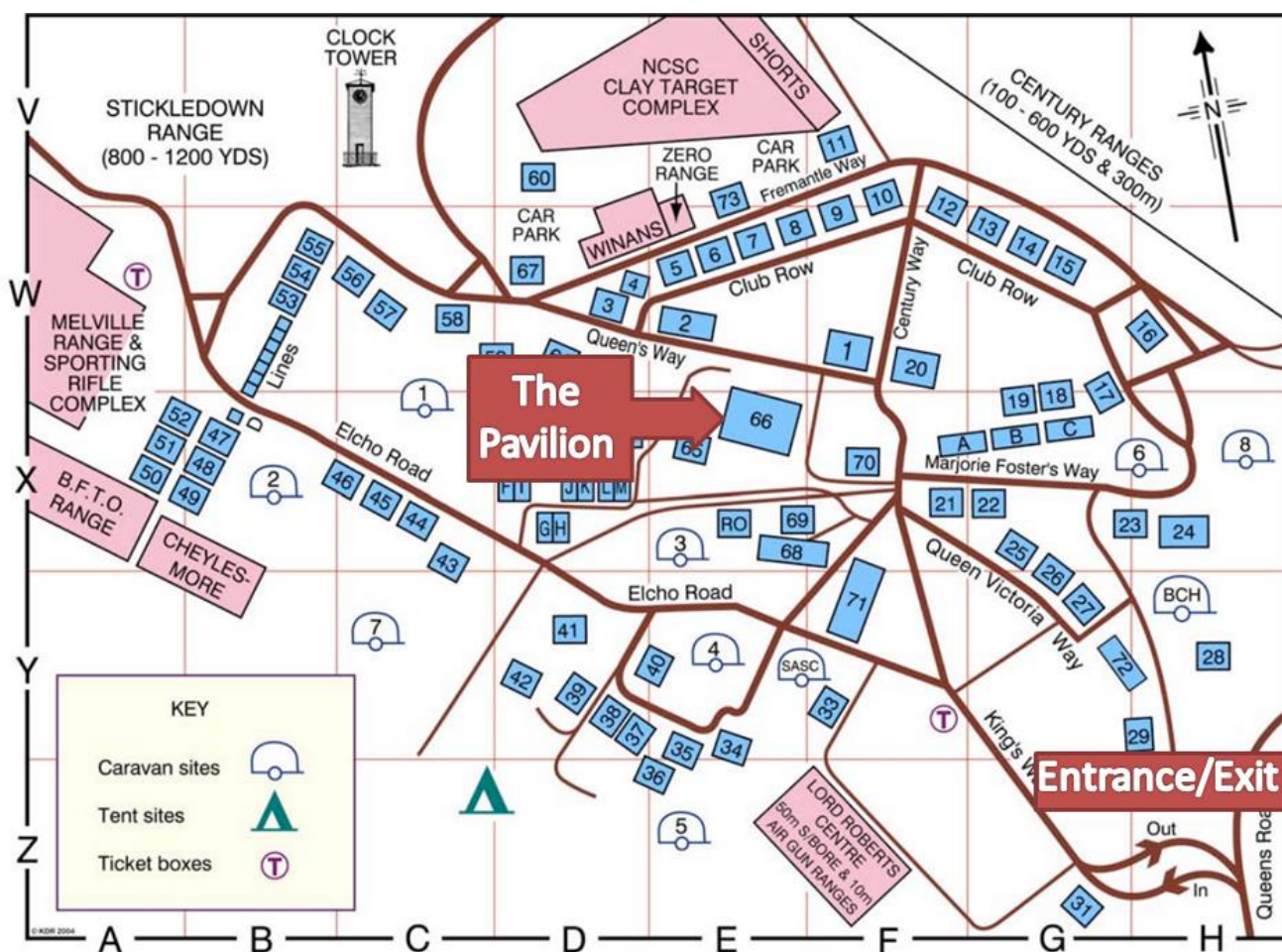
