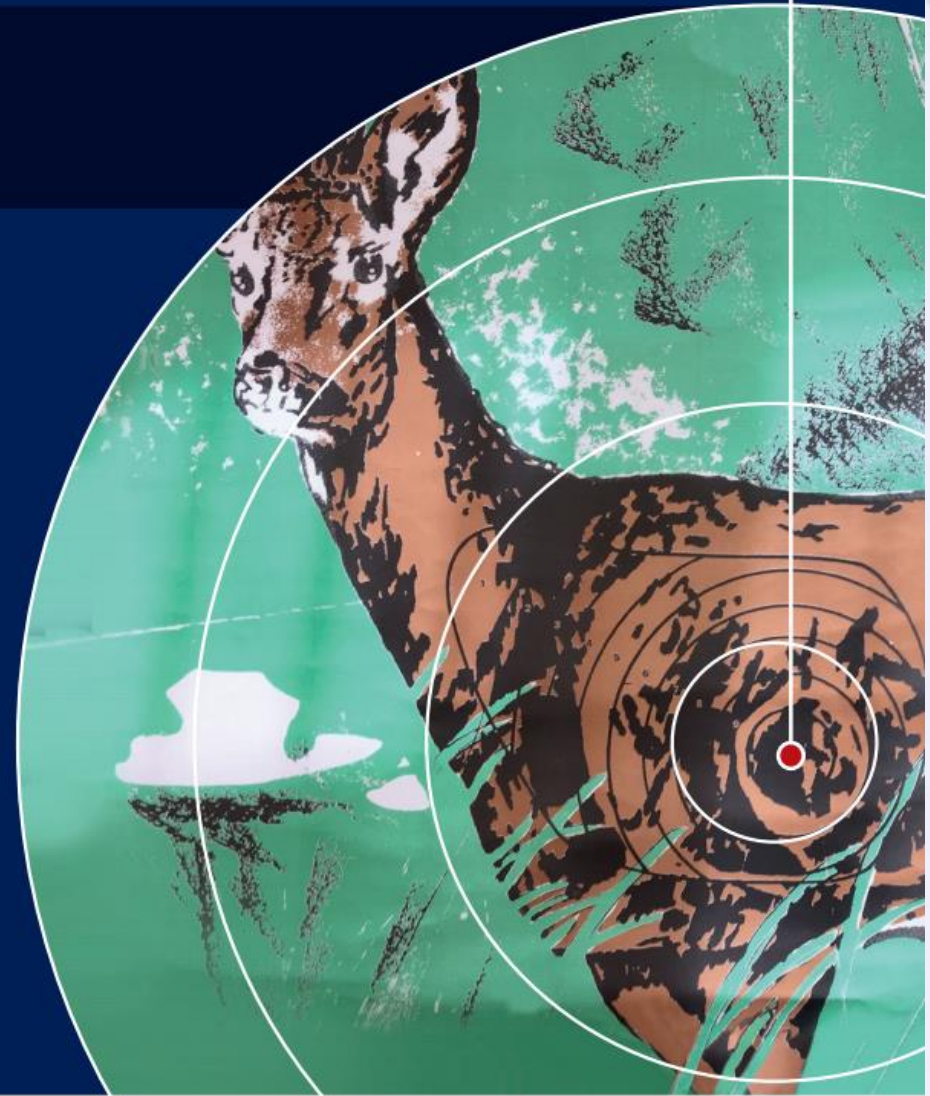

Bay A

- Pistol calibre Gallery Rifles and Shotgun (Birdshot/Buckshot only)

Bay B - Canopy

- Fullbore, Gallery Rifle, Solid Slug

Bays can be booked separately, or concurrently by the same or two different clubs

New booking System

- Be able to see availability online and search for specific dates – no more battleships
- Provide a list of suggested dates (1200x)
- Will give an insight to safety/fallbacks on range

PROCEDURAL CHANGES

Bookings

- **Dramatically reducing bookings!!**
 - Competitions result in a specific layout of the ranges
 - Often we have to decline other bookings
 - We will keep a close eye on this next year
- **400x practice on weekdays and weekends over winter dependent on range availability**
- **Club bookings must be made under clubs login details – not individuals**
 - No insurance cover unless part of a club booking
 - Please contact the range office if unsure of login details
 - Issue with too many people for one club making the same booking
- **You must ensure membership and safe shooters card are on you at all times**

Targets

- Civ SR Practice – bolt on targets only, no handhelds (Fig11, Fig12, Fig12c, DP14)
 - Clubs can bring in their own H/H but must be approved first
- **Ensure you use the correct target for your required distance**
- **Do not stick other targets on top of standard NRA Faces.**
 - Request in your booking a blank screen – make sure everything stays within the black lines
- Self-Marking
 - Please use black stickers on black and white stickers on white
 - When shooting is finished, targets are to be taken out of the frames and stacked in the correct pile

Markers

- **Private markers are the clubs responsibility**
 - The club will be accountable for any damage/vandalism caused by private markers
- **Issues with markers**
 - Bring this up at the time of the incident (not after shooting has finished) by contacting the range office (channel 16 on radio or ext 152). We will then resolve the problem in a timely manner
 - Markers must pass an assessment before being hired. This involves being able to mark the target in an average of 20 seconds. If your marker is taking 30+ (bad weather conditions can cause delayed marking) please get in contact
- Treatment of markers – Keeping your marker updated on the situation (breaks/change of shooter/falling back) ensures a better working relationship
- Some markers will attempt to give feedback so keep your radio switched on

Other Information

Firearms are not to be on the point before shooting commences at 0830 and 1330!!

- **Radios must be returned to the range office as soon as shooting has finished** – they need to be reallocated for the afternoon
- **No cars on the range**
- **Do not park within or at the end of Century Butts.**
 - Short Siberia car park or by Jennys are the nearest parking points
- **Zero Range**
 - Affiliated club members can use it the day of and day prior to their booking

COMMUNICATION

- All information regarding dates will be posted on the website
- Bulletin will contain details of changes and range activity
- Bookings will start to be confirmed over the next couple weeks

New Range Regulations will be out soon – make sure you read them!

Relocation of Range Office

- Separation of the Range Control and Reception
- Reception staff will not be able to deal with future bookings
- All bookings will have to be submitted electronically
- Café
- Retail facility

- Screens showing lane allocation (ease and speed flow)
- Map showing live ranges
- Members able to sign on for range electronically
