1. **The Role.** The Council for Cadet Rifle Shooting promotes and organises the sport of target rifle shooting across the 4 cadet youth movements (the Combined Cadet Force, the Sea Cadet Corps, the Army Cadet Force and the Air Training Corps). The charity's Shooting Manager is responsible for planning, organising and overseeing the conduct of all CCRS shooting activities throughout the year. This is an exciting opportunity for those who are passionate about contributing to the development of young people and helping them become responsible citizens.

2. **Deliverables.** Main tasks will be:

- a. Plan and organise: national finals across the major shooting disciplines, winter postal competitions, courses and conferences.
- b. Assist with the selection of UK international teams; help with the hosting of teams visiting the UK.
- c. Manage and control rifles and ammunition. Secondary duties will include health and safety and security.
