

INTRODUCTION TO TARGET SHOTGUN COURSE SATURDAY 17 OR SUNDAY 18 FEBRUARY 2018

AIM

The Target Shotgun (TS) Skills Development Course will provide the fundamental skills for taking part in TS events and competitions, and will include individual coaching of positional shooting techniques. The course is open to full NRA members and any other person over 14 years who is not a prohibited person under section 21 of the Firearms Act and pays the additional Non-NRA Member Fee of £6.85.

The 1-day course is being run on two separate days and will involve both classroom and practical range work with expert coaching from national and international level shooters.

SHOOTER CERTIFICATION CARD (SCC) - NRA MEMBERS ONLY

This will be available if pre-booked - there is no additional fee for this however you will need to revise the NRA Target Shotgun Manual prior to attending the course as there is a written test to complete and pass.

COURSE FEE

The course fee is £73.50, which includes range fees, targets, individual coaching and lunch. Ammunition and firearms are not included and attendees are expected to bring their own.

Those not yet in possession of a firearm will be able to hire a suitable shotgun, and purchase Section 2 ammunition on the day.

CANCELLATION FEE

Courses cancelled within 5 working days of course date will be subject to a cancellation fee of £20.00

DRESS AND EQUIPMENT

Attendees should bring warm and weatherproof clothing and appropriate footwear in case of inclement weather. You will need:

- Safety glasses
- Ear defenders
- Firearm a magazine fed shotgun (tube or box) either S1 or S2*
- Approximately 100 rounds of Birdshot (max size UK 4s, Fibre wads only) and 30 slug (if permitted to possess)
- Cartridge belt
- Normal shooting equipment
- Notebook and pencil
- * note that under the Firearms Act you are NOT permitted to borrow or use a high capacity firearm or solid slug ammunition without possessing a FIREARMS licence that permits you to possess such items.

Please be advised that you will be shooting prone and the ground may be muddy. Assistance in resetting targets and clearing spent cases is mandatory.

Tea and coffee will be available during the classroom sessions of the course at no extra charge.



 - o I will only shoot with airguns that are exempt from the requirements of S1 and S5 Firearms Act 1968 (as amended) and/or with shotguns falling within the limits of S2 Firearms Act 1968 (as amended)
- I agree that my name, competitor number, shooting class and score may be published on the internet or elsewhere following this competition
- I agree that I have been warned that ear protection must be worn at all times in the vicinity of all firing points while shooing is in progress and shall not hold the organiser responsible for any damages to my hearing as a result from any non-compliance therewith
