CHOBHAM RIDGE – SHOOTERS ROUTINE

0900 – Report to the large classroom in the Pavilion where you will be signed in. Please maintain social distancing.

0910 – Initial safety brief

0930 – Travel in private vehicles to Chobham Ridge Range

0950 – RO to give on range safety brief, request permission to “Go Live”

1000 - Firing commences under control of NSC RO

1230 – Stoppage for Stickledown Marker access/egress

1315 – Stoppage for Stickledown Marker access/egress

1400 Ceasefire (Shooting may be extended if Stickledown stoppages are prolonged)

1. You will be required to travel to the range in your own vehicle, the track into the firing point is “unmade” and quite rough but is negotiable by most standard cars. Please do not attempt to drive low slung sports cars to the firing point and beware there is nowhere to leave vehicles at the access point.
2. Directions to the Range will be provided on the day.
3. Your first shot must prove zero on a shotmarker target at approx. 200x. Once zero has been proven you will be permitted to progress on to the steel plates under the direction of the NSC instructor, gradually increasing the distance to a maximum of 900x. If you cannot prove zero you will not be permitted to shoot.

Range Notices and Regulations

4. It is an individual responsibility to be aware of, and comply with, range regulations and instructions issued on the day. You must read the range regulations which can be downloaded from the website.

Permitted firearms and ammunition

Max .308

HME firearms are not permitted on this range

Opening Times

Friday, Saturday, Sunday.

Shooting time 1000 – 1400 but may vary slightly on the day dependent on stoppages.

Distances

Steel plates between approximate distances of 200 and 900x.
