

EXCLUDING POLICE TRAINING REQUIREMENTS

- All bookings must be pre-booked online. Walk-ins are not permitted without an online booking.

RANGE PAYMENTS

- Pre-Payments are mandatory before your range booking unless you have previously made us aware (note in range booking) you are to be invoiced.
- Please pay via the online system where possible by selecting the green tick. Alternatively call the Range Office on ext 152 to make payment over the phone.
- Range bookings must be attributed to an individual who is responsible for “Test and Trace” within the group.
- All 1:1 training (Probationary/Guest Days) must be notified in the range booking comments box or via email to the range office

Lane Allocation

- The range lane allocation is now displayed online the day prior to your booking

- Due to GDPR if the booking is made by an individual member you will be able to be identified only by your booking reference number
- You can still check this on the day outside the back of the range office, where radios are also now issued

Undercover Firing point Butt 14 back for Winter

- 15 steel targets at varied distances in the danger area
- 2 people firing at any one time with individual spotter
- 5 people plus mandatory NSC RO
- Shooting approx. 1000-1400
- £500

PROCEDURES

Range Safety Boards are there for a reason!

DO NOT IGNORE OR MOVE THEM!

Firearms are not to be on the point before shooting commences at 0830 and 1330!!


Do not remove a loaded firarm from the firing point, if you have a round stuck in the chamber request assistance or wait for a member of staff to clear the range.

If you arrive at the range early please wait for staff to open the range/gate - mornings are extremely busy

The gates on the ranges will close 30 minutes after shooting.

If you have not vacated there will be the security guards number available. Please note they do not arrive on camp until 1800

Anger and aggression towards staff will not be tolerated.

- 
- Sporting stance lanes – crossed off for safety. It is not an extra lane!! You will be charged and reported to the range safety/disciplinary committee
 - Muzzle brakes no longer allocated extra safety lane. If you do not wish to be plotted next to a muzzle brake please inform us in the comments of your booking and we will do our best to accommodate

- When booking please select one of the following options (*range* may vary):
 - ‘*Century* Electronic’ to be for specific hourly slot
 - ‘*Century* Electronic (Session)’ to be for the whole AM/PM session
 - Selecting the wrong option may mean you are incorrectly charged.

Shotmarker – The system can be accessed by any wireless enabled device. Although a tablet will be provided you may wish to use your own tablet or smartphone.

Please be aware the following calibres are unlikely to register on the electronic targets:

- .17
- .22

You must ensure all rifles are zeroed prior to using the electronic targets as sensitive electronic equipment may be damaged by inaccurate shooting. The user will be liable for any damage caused to the electronic targetry.

Please report any fault with an electronic target immediately to Range Control.

HME PROCEDURE

- If using the Zero Range at the NSC the adapted HME zero cards are permitted (Match Rifle, F Class, 300 Win Mag)
- If the zero range is not available or you are planning to shoot outside of the NSC or under 200x then you must:
 - Short Range (200x or less): Small round black disc 8" in diameter
 - Long Range: 3 piece target
- All of the above must be monitored by an RCO (HME) and signed off

Home Loaded Ammunition

Range Safety Supervisors will conduct random checks using the lab radar to ensure ammunition is within the muzzle energy limits of the range.

If bringing ammunition for competitions it is advised to bring extra rounds in case you are subject to testing.

When asked you are required to:

- Supply one round of home load ammunition for disassembling
- Provide details of the bullet in use, which will subsequently be weighed
- Shoot one or more rounds to allow MV to be recorded

Failure to comply will result in being asked to leave the range

DO NOT RELOAD AMMUNITION AT THE REAR OF THE RANGE

Markers

- **Cancellations to Markers**

- Markers are allocated work on a Monday. When bookings are cancelled we have to retract their work allocation
- When this happens on numerous occasions we lose marker reliability and they begin to look elsewhere for work
- Our pool of markers is limited. Please be considerate when requesting

- **Private markers are the clubs responsibility**

- The club will be accountable for any damage/vandalism caused by private markers
- Private markers radios are to be collected and handed out by the club
- Access to Stickledown will be latest 0815 and 1315. We will not wait for private markers to arrive

- **Issues with markers**

- We cannot guarantee they will turn up on the day. You will still be charged for the target hire.
- Markers must pass an assessment before being hired. This involves being able to mark the target in an average of 20 seconds. If your marker is taking 30+ (bad weather conditions can cause delayed marking) please get in contact
- Other issues inform the range office at the time of the incident (not after shooting has finished). We will then resolve the problem in a timely manner
- Treatment of markers – Keeping your marker updated on the situation (breaks/change of shooter/falling back) ensures a better working relationship
- Some markers will attempt to give feedback so keep your radio switched on

Affiliated club members can use it the day of and day prior to their booking


Guest days are to be notified to Surrey Firearms Licensing Department


- Must also select tick box on booking application form

Cancellation Policy

- High Season Weekends, the cancellation policy is midnight on Tuesday
- Bookings taken after this time will be for a standard/electronic target and no marker. Bench cannot be guaranteed



FALL BACKS

Competition Booking Effect

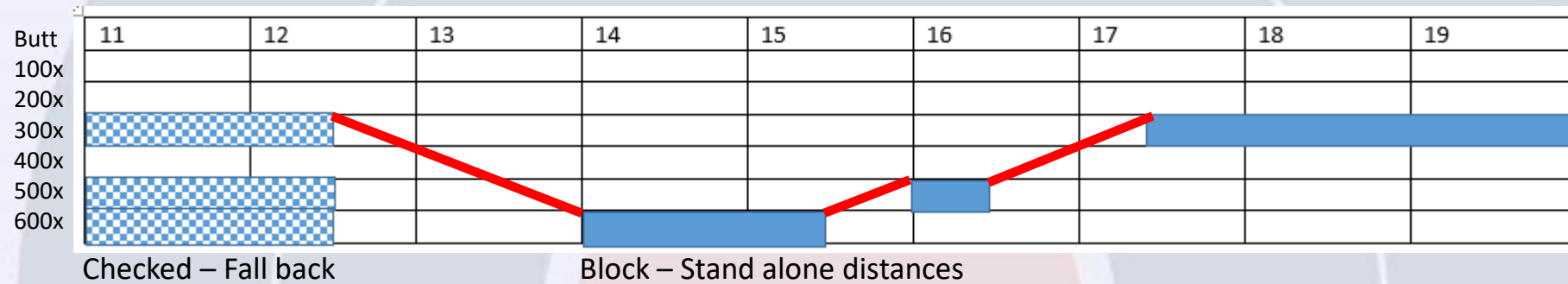
- Competitions and fall backs result in a specific layout of the ranges

Change in booking allocation from 2021

- Century - Only 1 fall back layout on the range at a time – No independent fall backs
- Stickledown – 2 different fall backs can be permitted however fall backs on the day of bookings will need to be coordinated

We can only use the left hand side of Century when we have priority. We will be granted priority on the weekends where large competitions have been requested. Due to this, If there is no competition taking place then there will be no fall back permitted in advance.

E.g. 18 lanes @ 3/5/600x fall back



Result:

1. Enhanced range safety
 - Fallbacks all happening together under control
2. Increase range availability
 - Reducing lanes used on safety space
 - Reducing number of lanes double booked
3. Increase Staff Efficiency
 - Effect of cancellations reduced thus reducing requirement to rewrite range plot

Timings

If 2 distances being shot the fall back will be approx. half way through session (1030 or 1530)

If 3 distances being shot the fall back will be approx. every hour

The above will vary and the largest competition on the range will have overall RO responsibilities to be liaised with Range Control

Range Safety Staff will be on the range at approx. fall back times

Weekday Fall backs

Due to limited range space during the week to compensate for multiple distances being available; fall backs during the week will only be able to be confirmed up to 1 week prior once range availability can be confirmed

Mcqueen Castles Short Siberia

Due to limited range space during the weekend when 200x is in play, we cannot guarantee Mcqueen Castles will be available on Short Siberia

Subject to availability Century 300x Mcqueens will be available on weekends

Winans/Butt Zero Hourly
