THE RANGE	
Name	Cheylesmore Non Standard No Danger Area Range
Description	Cheylesmore Range consists of 3x 25m bays. Bay A contains 2 x banks of ISSF targets Bay B contains 20 x turning targets in 4 x banks of 5 Bay C contains 2 x Overhead Retrievable Targets (ORT)
CHEYLESMORE – BAY A	
FIREARMS AND AMMUNITION	
Firearms and ammunition that may be fired on the range including ME & MV	1. Target Pistol only: a. Pardini .22 and .32 conversion kit b. Walther SSP/SSPE .22 c. Fienwerkbau AW93 .22 2. Only the CE can permit use of Bay A by personnel other than the GB Pistol/Troops to Target squads or firearms other than .22/.32 target pistol. This authority cannot be delegated.
RANGE SAFETY LIMITATIONS	
Coordinating Instructions	1. Bay A and the Club Room are to be secure whilst firearms are present. 2. A Suitably Qualified Experienced Person (SQEP) is to be appointed as the responsible RO for each training session/competition. 3. Changes of position are permitted within any detail or practise providing all firers follow the same sequence. 4. Fire and movement is not permitted on Cheylesmore Bay A 5. Alcohol is not permitted in the Club Room.
Firing Positions	All shooting is to be from the standing or benched position.
Targetry	1. Unless prior permission has been obtained from the CE only ISSF (Megalink) targets may be used within Bay A. 2. Targets are not to be moved from the 25m target line
