<b>Permitted firearms and ammunition including ME &amp; MV</b>	<b>Type:</b> Gallery Rifles and Pistols <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Maximum Muzzle Velocity:</b> 655 m/s (2150 ft/s)</li> <li>• <b>Maximum Muzzle Energy:</b> 2030 J (1496 ft lb)</li> </ul> <b>Not Permitted:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 22 Hornet</li> <li>• .17 HMR</li> <li>• Muzzle loading rifles and pistols</li> </ul>
<b>RANGE SAFETY LIMITATIONS</b>	
<b>Coordinating Instructions</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Shooting on this range has no effect on any other ranges.</li> <li>2. <b>Access:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. If Civil police are using Bay B, Bay C cannot be used</li> </ol> </li> <li>3. Range infrastructure is not to be used as targetry or to zero/check firearms.</li> <li>4. Targets are not to be engaged whilst moving.</li> </ol>
<b>Firing Positions</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>5. <b>Positions Permitted:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Benched</li> </ol> </li> <li>6. There is to be no movement forward of the firing point.</li> <li>7. Targets are only to be engaged at 25m.</li> </ol>
<b>Targetry</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>8. <b>MAX TCH: 1.5m</b></li> <li>9. Unless prior permission has been obtained from the CE only targets from the NRA approved set may be used.</li> <li>10. Targets are to be used in the frames or holders provided and are to be engaged only from the recognised firing points and /or appropriate shooting station or peg. Any deviation from this is to be notified, in writing, and approved by the Head of Range Services.</li> </ol>
