2. Competitors are required to be members of the NRA and hold a valid Shooting Certificate for the rifle being used, both to be shown to the Safety Officer before score cards can be drawn.
3. Entries by post, including remittance, should be received by Thursday 26 April. Thereafter they can only be accepted if space is available subject to the late entry fee to reflect the charge for changes in target booking. Entries will be acknowledged by email. Space is limited so early entries are advised.
4. All trophies (except the English VIII Club Jewels) are held for one year. Previous winners are required to return them, appropriately engraved and polished, in time to be displayed at the reception on the Saturday.
