150th IMPERIAL MEETING 2019 ENTRY NOTES

Please read through these notes carefully before completing the entry form.

1. Entering the Imperial Meeting

We encourage you to use this paper form only for reference, and to make your entry and pay securely online. Entering via the website is quicker, and your entry fees and discounts will be calculated automatically. To enter the Imperial Meeting online please visit www.nra.org.uk.

Entries will not be accepted for any match after 12 noon on the day preceding the match unless special conditions apply.

2. TRID Number

Your Target Rifle ID (TRID) is a unique index number that allows us to match up your scores from previous Imperial Meetings. Your TRID is listed on your membership profile and on our website when searching from previous Imperial results: <https://nra.org.uk/scores>.

Please use your TRID wherever possible so we do not duplicate entries in the Class lists or team records. If you do not have a TRID please leave this field blank and one will be assigned to you; alternatively contact the Squadding Department for help.

3. Eligibility

You may list two Clubs: Primary (listed on all prize lists) and Secondary (for use by captains in team selection).

You may list up to three Counties you are eligible to shoot for, please state them in order of preference. Please also state which Country you are eligible to shoot for even if you do not intend to shoot in international matches, as this is required to calculate your eligibility into certain aggregates and special duty exemptions.

Your date of birth is required to calculate entry fees correctly.

All competitors must sign the declaration at the bottom of the payment page. Failure to do so may require the return of your entry form for correction.

4. Shooter Certification Card (SCC)

All competitors must produce their SCC at the NRA Competition Reception in order to collect their squadding cards. In the case of overseas competitors the relevant certificate must be signed by their own National Governing Body.

5. Overseas Competitors

Applications for Visitors Firearms Permits should be made at your earliest opportunity, and no later than 1 May 2019. Applications made after this date may not be processed in time for the Imperial Meeting. Please use the VFP application form available as a download on the NRA website. Competitors from within the European Community must include a valid European Firearms Pass where applicable.

6. Record of Rifles Used

All competitors must provide details of the rifle(s) to be used during the Meeting as required by the Firearms (Amendment) Acts 1997. If necessary, please make an appropriate note and continue on a separate sheet.

If you are under the age of 19 and are shooting the TR events of the Imperial Meeting with an issued L81A2 Cadet Target Rifle, please tick the relevant box on this entry form.

7. Classification of Competitors

If an overseas competitor is not yet in possession of an NRA GB classification, they should state their home country's class to aid Shooting Division in determining the class to be used during the Meeting. Full details regarding overseas classifications can be found in the NRA Handbook.

8. Muzzle Energy

Ranges at Bisley use the Danger Area of Pirbright Range, which under MoD requirements state that all firearms used must either have a muzzle energy under 4,500 Joules (3,319 ft lbs), or else be zeroed at 200 yards or on the Bisley Zero Range prior to being used at a longer distance. This does not affect TR, but may affect MR, F Class or Sporting Rifle. If your ME exceeds the limit then you must zero your rifle, using the specially designed target, the day before the start of your particular Meeting.

9. F Class Competitions

F Class competitions can be defined as F Open or F/TR, full details are defined in Para 164 of the NRA Handbook.

F Open and F/TR competitors may either supply their own handloaded ammunition or purchase commercially available ammunition, including GGG which will be available only from the Range Office. All handloaded ammunition must comply with NRA Range Safety Regulations and conform to CIP standards.

10. Match Rifle Competitions

All competitors taking part in the Match Rifle Meeting must supply their own ammunition. MR competitors may use any ammunition, including handloads, but those entering the GGG Aggregate must use purchased GGG ammunition from the Range Office.

11. Shooting Mentors (Aunts and Uncles) Scheme

Any competitor, particularly those entering for the first time, can benefit from mentoring by an "Aunt" or "Uncle" (an experienced competitor who will advise and assist). To request this service please complete the appropriate box on the entry form. You will be contacted prior to the Meeting with further details. Any suitably experienced competitors who would like to volunteer to be a mentor should contact the Squadding Department.

12. OTF Swindles (Queen's and Albert)

The OTF Swindles provides valuable support to all GB and NRA teams travelling overseas including Under 25, TR, MR and F Class.

Entries are allocated randomly to teams of ten (TR: concurrent with Queen's I), and teams of four (MR: concurrent with Albert) with similar proportions of each shooting class.

Multiple entries are encouraged and increase your chances of winning team or individual prizes.

13. Chairman's Prize

The Chairman's Prize is free to enter and is held on the morning of Second Friday, open to the top 50 competitors in each Class O and T in the Grand Aggregate. Full details can be found in the Bisley Bible.

14. Discounts

Competitors aged under 25 on the last day of the Meeting are eligible for 40% discount off their entry fees.

All entries received before midday Friday 31st May 2019 can claim a 10% discount off entry fees, in addition to any age discounts if applicable.

Discounts are applicable to entry fees only (i.e. not sweeps).

15. Early Entry Draw

Open to all entries over £50 received by midday 30th April 2019.

16. Membership of the NRA

17. Requests for Special Squadding

Requests for special squadding (e.g. the same or different details as another competitor) must be received before midday Friday 28th June, are only processed if considered reasonable, and cannot be guaranteed.

18. Payment

19. Cancellation Fee

Any cancellations received after midday Monday 1st July will incur a 10% fee.

20. Return of Receipts

A receipt of your entry will be sent via email/post shortly after your entry has been processed. If any of the information is incorrect you should inform the Squadding Department before the Imperial Meeting commences. Your Bisley Bible (if ordered) may be collected at registration.

21. Special Duties

All domestic competitors under 70 years of age are liable for special duties unless exemption, supported by a current Doctor's certificate is provided. Competitors required to perform Special Duties will be expected to carry them out, since they are not transferable. If you are over 70 but would like Special Duties please include a note to this effect.

22. Prize Lists

Prize Lists are displayed periodically throughout the Meeting outside the Main NRA building. After the Meeting they will be published on the NRA website, and made into a CD and paperback book. CDs cost £5.50, a free copy is available to each competitor entering the Grand Aggregate or the Hopton Match Rifle Aggregate (when stated upon entry).

23. Medals and Bars

Listed in the NRA Handbook are details of each competition and the subsequent awards that are available to competitors. Please state upon entry if you wish to receive any awards you may achieve during the Meeting, if this is left blank we will assume you do not wish to receive them.
