#### F-class competition (FTR and F-Open):

2 convertible sighters and 15 shots at 300, 500, 600, 1000, 1100 yards.

Prizes in each F-class discipline for the Long-Range and Short-Range Competitions and the Aggregate. A trophy for the aggregate winner in each discipline.

Marking - Paid markers are booked for all competitions.

Conditions - NRA Rules and Regulations will apply unless otherwise stated.

Ammunition – TR - only .308 ammunition, using a bullet not exceeding 156gr.
F-Class – ammunition in accordance with NRA rules.
If hand-loaded ammunition is being used, it must be shown on the competitor's SCC.

Booking-in from 6.00pm – 9.00pm Friday 12<sup>th</sup> and 7.30am – 8.00am Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> in the Ibis Clubhouse, (between the City and the NLRC) on production of 2024 Shooter Certification card.

First detail will commence at 8.30am at 300 yards

HME firers must declare this on the entry form and will be squadded in the second detail AM. They must, during the first detail (or the day before), fire an HME special zero target on the Zero range and produce it to the Ibis RCO before shooting.
