We look forward to welcoming you to The Phoenix Meeting 2019, the NRA's annual festival of shooting; with Gallery Rifle and Pistol, Target Shotgun, Full-bore, Classic and Historic, and McQueen event spread across Bisley ranges from 10 to 1000 yards.

Entries must be received no later than midday on Wednesday 8th May

Entries will be accepted on each day of the Phoenix, however these will not benefit from advance squadding and are subject to range availability.

MEETING NOTES:

- **Eye Protection** - It is a Meeting rule that all competitors are required to wear hearing and eye protection (unless otherwise stated in individual event conditions). The NRA will not be liable for any injury sustained through the lack of appropriate protection. Please see the NRA policy statement on eye protection on the website.
- **Entries** - All entries are subject to a £1 per event (max. £5) Meeting fee.
- **Discounts** -
 - Entering 6 or more events entitles you to a **10% discount** off your total event fees
 - Entering 12 or more events entitles you to a **20% discount** off your total event fees
 - Entering 20 or more events entitles you to a **25% discount** off your total event fees
 - **30% discount** is available if this is your first entry to an NRA Meeting
 - **40% discount** is available for those that are under 25 years old on the last day of the Meeting
- **Entry Deadline** - Late entries make squadding and administration very difficult. Entry forms postmarked after 8th May will incur an additional fee of £1 per event entered. These entries may not benefit from advance squadding.
- **Cancellations** - Entry fees are refundable, less an administration fee of £5, if written notice of cancellation is received at the NRA by midday Friday 17th May. Any requests for refunds after this date are at the discretion of the Meeting Director.
- **Event Conditions** - Conditions and courses of fire are listed in the GR&P Handbook which can be found online and in a FREE paperback book available from NRA Reception.
- **Your Support** - It is a condition of entry that all competitors are expected to support the Meeting by assisting as requested, i.e. re-facing targets and acting as Safety Supervisors.
- **Results** - Results are posted periodically on the Stats boards outside the Main NRA Building and online so you can view interim results on your phone or other internet enabled device. Provisional and subsequent confirmed results are available online after the completion of the Meeting.
- **Target Shotgun** - Target Shotgun Events - Iron Sight for matches 0735, 0736, 1135, 1136, 3335, 3336. There will be an 'Iron Sights' checkbox on the scorecard.
- **Certification** - From 1st January 2009, each civilian shooting on a MoD range is to carry a Shooter Certification Card (SCC) signed by the chairman of a club of which he is a member and which is affiliated to the NRA. Competitors MUST produce their SCC before being allowed to shoot. Full details on this subject can be found on the NRA website.

Round 4 of the NRA Handgun League 2019 Practical Pistol Match - Sunday 26th May

General

Standard guns required to fit IPSC Standard box (with allowance for extensions and barrels).

The match is limited to 54 competitors.

Please note this is a half-day match, sign in and Safety Briefings - Sunday 26th May on Butt Zero:

- AM Detail: Shoot between 0830-1200 hrs, Report time 0800 hrs
- PM Detail: Shoot between 1330-1630 hrs, Report time 1200 hrs

The match can be shot without a Shooter Certification Card, with one-to-one supervision by an NRA Certified RCO. Please advise in advance if this is the case.

Events

- 3521 **Open** - any .22 LBP with any sights, no restriction on holster or mag pouch location.
- 3524 **Standard** - any .22 LBP, holster and mag pouches to be worn behind the hip. Optical sights not permitted.
- 3522 **Revolver Open:** any centre fire LBR with any sights, no restriction on holster or mag pouch location.

MATCH CONDITIONS

1. **Scoring** - scoring will be in line with NRA and IPSC handbooks. You will require a minimum of 130 rounds of ammunition. Targets will be from 2m to 35m and be a mixture of paper and steels. Competitors are required to assist with resetting/patching, failure to do so may incur procedural penalties or disqualification.
2. **Safety Catch** - your pistol must be fitted with an operational manual safety catch or decocker unless shooting in revolver division.
3. **Holster Test** - if your equipment fails the retention test you will start from the Tyro position where a drop leg holstered start is required. Shoulder and cross draw holsters are prohibited. The Match Director, will be the final arbiter as to whether any holster or firearm may be used.
4. **Tyro Starts** - persons not using a holster will be allowed to start in the Tyro position but will be subject to 1 procedural penalty per occurrence.

- Each shooter must enter the appropriate individual events; the scores will carry forward to contribute to the overall team score. Each member of the team can shoot at any time during the meeting. Scores from LBP / LBR iron sights and GRCF Classic events will qualify if 'standard' T&P1 and M-T events have not been entered.
- Entry and team member declarations must be received before the first member of the team shoots either event.
- Prizes:
 - 1st Prize NRA Gold medals
 - 2nd Prize NRA Silver medals if the number of entries exceeds 5
 - 3rd Prize NRA Bronze medals if the number of entries exceeds 8
