Notes:		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Target Position: 6 plates, 20 inches centre to centre, about 6 feet to bottom. • Timer: RO will require a timer; a shot timer is ideal as it will confirm any late shots. • Movement: Firearms are unbagged at the greatest distance and shooters move, under CRO control, to the closest distance. Given the need to move back between Stages, at the end of each Stage, after firearms are cleared, the RO gives the commands: “MUZZLES UP”; LBP/LBR MAY BE HOLSTERED. Wait until all ready. “TAKE YOUR FIREARMS AND EQUIPMENT AND, AS A LINE, MOVE BACK TO THE NEXT POSITION” Check for stragglers and that firearms remain “Muzzles Up” or holstered until the command to “CHECK AND ADJUST” is given (no need to clear). If plates can be reset without going forward (e.g. rope pull), ROs may walk competitors back muzzle up instead of bagging; in this case, unbag at 25m, then move to 10m to start the match. Range Commands

Notes:

- **Target Position:** 2 targets, 7 ½ feet centre to centre, about 6 feet to top.
- **Barricade at each distance:** 6 feet high, 2 feet wide, foot fault lines running back from each edge. (Shooters may step back from the platform)
- **Movement:** Firearms are unbagged at the greatest distance and shooters move, under CRO control, to the closest distance. Given the need to move back between Stages, at the end of each Stage, after firearms are cleared, the RO gives the commands: **“MUZZLES UP”; LBP/LBR MAY BE HOLSTERED.** Wait until all ready. **“TAKE YOUR FIREARMS AND EQUIPMENT AND, AS A LINE, MOVE BACK TO THE NEXT POSITION”** Check for stragglers and that firearms remain “Muzzles Up” or holstered until the command to **“CHECK AND ADJUST”** is given (no need to clear).
- **Use of barricade:** In an exception to rule B6.8.2, the gun may be held and fired by either hand regardless of which side of the barricade is being used.

- **“SHOOTERS TO THE LINE”** **“UNBAG AND SHOW CLEAR”** – ROs check each firearm is clear
- CRO reads out the Course of Fire and checks understanding.
- **“CHECK AND ADJUST”** – shooters may check their firearms and adjust their sights onto the target
- Having checked that the range is clear and shooters appear ready, the CRO commands **“LOAD AND MAKE READY”**. Having given time to load and make ready, the CRO commands **“ARE YOU READY?”** Silence will be taken as agreement – any competitor who is not ready may shout or raise one arm, after which the CRO will confirm **“NOT READY CALLED”** and repeat until silence.

- **Target Position:** 1 target, about 6 feet to top.
- **Target Movement:** Target will move from cover, travel 60 feet in 6s, then disappear behind cover.
- **Firing Area:** Clearly marked 3 foot square area at each distance, centre of target run.
- **Competitors:** Only be 1 competitor will be shooting at a time.
- **Competitor Movement:** Firearm is unbagged at the greatest distance, and shooter moves, under CRO control to the closest distance. Given the need to move back between Stages, at the end of each Stage, after firearm is cleared, the RO gives the commands: **“MUZZLES UP”; LBP/LBR MAY BE HOLSTERED.** Wait until the shooter is ready, then **“BACK TO THE NEXT POSITION”** Check that firearm remains “Muzzle Up” or holstered until the command to **“CHECK AND ADJUST”** is given (no need to clear). Firearm must be bagged at the end of the match
