### **Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> & Sunday 31<sup>st</sup> March**

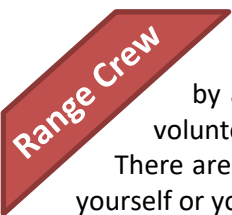
We look forward to welcoming you to the first 'Action Weekend' of 2019

#### **CERTIFICATION:**

From 1st January 2009, each civilian shooting on a MoD range is to carry a Shooter Certification Card (SCC) signed by the chairman of a club of which he is a member and which is affiliated to the NRA. Competitors MUST produce their SCC before being allowed to shoot. Full details on this subject can be found on the NRA website.

#### **NEW 2019:**

Stats will be periodically uploaded online during the weekend so you can view interim results on your phone or other internet enabled device.

#### **NOTES:**

- Entering 6 or more events entitles to you to a **10% discount** off your total event fees
- Entering 12 or more events entitles to you to a **20% discount** off your total event fees
- **30% discount** is available if this is your first entry to an NRA Meeting
- **40% discount** is available for those that are under 25 years old on the last day of the Meeting
- Special requests: please attach a separate note for squadding and other requests to your entry return
- It is a condition of entry that all competitors are expected to support the Meeting by assisting as requested e.g. re-facing targets and acting as Safety Supervisors.

- On the first day of the competition I will be aged fourteen years or over
- I meet at least one of the following conditions:
  - I hold a Firearm Certificate permitting me to use the firearms that I shall fire in this competition for target shooting
  - I am a full member of a Home Office Approved Club and will be shooting as a full member of that club and will use any firearm for which I do not hold a Firearm Certificate only in accordance with the applicable exemptions to S1 Firearms Act 1968 as amended
  - I will only shoot with airguns that are exempt from the requirements of S1 and S5 Firearms Act 1968 (as amended) and/or with shotguns falling within the limits of S2 Firearms Act 1968 (as amended)
- I agree that my name, competitor number, shooting class and score may be published on the internet or elsewhere following this competition
- I agree to abide by the rules of the National Rifle Association and of the Meeting and I will accept the decisions of the Meeting Director or the NRA as final

5. PPM Open: Any .22 LBP with any sights, no restriction on holster or mag pouch location
6. PPM Standard: Any .22 LBP, holster and mag pouches to be worn behind the hip. Optical sights not permitted
7. PPM Revolver Open: Any centre fire LBR with any sights, no restriction on holster or mag pouch location

# Practical Pistol Match Round 2 of the NRA Handgun League 2019 Sunday 31<sup>st</sup> March 2019

### GENERAL

Standard guns required to fit IPSC Standard box (with allowance for extensions and barrels).

The match is limited to 54 competitors.

Please note this is a half-day match, sign in and Safety Briefings - Sunday 31<sup>st</sup> March on Butt Zero:

- AM Detail: Shoot between 0830-1200 hrs, Report time 0800 hrs
- PM Detail: Shoot between 1330-1630 hrs, Report time 1200 hrs

The match can be shot without a Shooter Certification Card, with one-to-one supervision by an NRA Certified RCO. Please advise on entry if this is the case.

### EVENTS

- 3521 **Open** - any .22 LBP with any sights, no restriction on holster or mag pouch location.
- 3524 **Standard** - any .22 LBP, holster and mag pouches to be worn behind the hip. Optical sights not permitted.
- 3522 **Revolver Open:** any centre fire LBR with any sights, no restriction on holster or mag pouch location.

### MATCH CONDITIONS

1. **Scoring** - scoring will be in line with NRA and IPSC handbooks. You will require a minimum of 130 rounds of ammunition. Targets will be from 2m to 35m and be a mixture of paper and steels. Competitors are required to assist with resetting/patching, failure to do so may incur procedural penalties or disqualification.
2. **Safety Catch** - your pistol must be fitted with an operational manual safety catch or decocker unless shooting in revolver division.
3. **Holster Test** - if your equipment fails the retention test you will start from the Tyro position where a drop leg holstered start is required. Shoulder and cross draw holsters are prohibited. The Match Director, will be the final arbiter as to whether any holster or firearm may be used.
4. **Tyro Starts** - persons not using a holster will be allowed to start in the Tyro position but will be subject to 1 procedural penalty per occurrence.

## **NRA Rapid Fire Pistol (2621)**

### **Event Numbers**

**2621:** LPB

### **Targets**

5 x PL17

### **Sights**

Any, spotting scopes may also be used

### **Positions**

Standing unsupported, strong hand only

### **Ready Position**

45 degrees, loaded and round chambered

Competitors must return to the ready position between each series of 5 shots

### **Course of Fire**

This event is shot at 25 metres. It takes approximately 20 minutes to complete. It requires 35 rounds. The maximum possible score is 300

### **Sighters**

5 shots in 10 seconds, 1 shot per target; targets to be patched or refaced afterwards

### **Practice 1**

5 shots in 10 seconds, 1 shot per target, fired twice

### **Practice 2**

5 shots in 8 seconds, 1 shot per target, fired twice

### **Practice 3**

5 shots in 6 seconds, 1 shot per target, fired twice

### **Range Commands**

The general rules apply with the addition of the following initial command. Having made sure that the range is clear, the CRO commands "WITH FIVE ROUNDS LOAD AND MAKE READY"

### **Scoring**

Targets will be scored at the end of the match, inward gauging. If there are more than 6 shots on any target, only the highest 6 will count

### **Ties**

Tie breaking rules shall be applied in the order listed below:

- a. By the greatest number of Xs in the event
- b. By the scores on each target in the order 5, 4, 3, 2, 1
- c. By the X count on each target in the order 5, 4, 3, 2, 1

### **Procedural Penalties**

In addition to the usual procedural penalties, the following apply in this event:

- a. Firing more than 5 shots in a string – one penalty per additional shot fired

### **Classifications**

There are no classifications for this event
