

NRA INTRODUCTION TO TARGET RIFLE COURSE Sunday 13th May 2018

AIM

The Introduction to Target Rifle (TR) course will provide those who have little or no experience of shooting TR with the fundamental skills to enable them to shoot TR competently with others at their clubs. The course will include individual coaching on shooting position and technique, adjusting the sights, zeroing the rifle and using score sheets.

The course is open to all NRA members and non-NRA members who have a Shooter Certification Card (SCC) for Iron Sighted Rifle, including those who do not currently hold an FAC or possess a Target Rifle. Non-NRA members can attend providing they are a full member of a Home Office approved club affiliated to the NRA and possess a Shooter Certification Card (SCC). An additional non-membership fee will also be applicable.

This is a one-day course and will involve both classroom and practical range work.

This course is being run in conjunction with the Bisley clubs and the location for the course will be the NRA Training Room (Rear of the Main NRA Building) on Bisley Camp.

COURSE FEE

The course fee is £73.50 (£44.10 for Under 25s) which includes individual coaching, range fees, markers, plotting sheets, shooting equipment if required (jacket, sling, glove) and lunch.

Ammunition and rifles are not included and attendees are expected to bring their own. If not yet in possession of a suitable target rifle, attendees can have use of an NRA rifle for £17.50 for the day (50% discount), and purchase ammunition (24 rds of 7.62mm at a cost of £19.68) which will be issued on the range.

CANCELLATION FEE

Courses cancelled within 5 working days of course date will be subject to a cancellation fee of £20.00.

DRESS AND EQUIPMENT

Attendees should wear their usual shooting clothing, with under layers according to the weather. Footwear suitable for soggy ranges and waterproof trousers and jackets should also be brought. Attendees should bring any shooting gear appropriate to TR that they have or usually borrow (e.g. from their club), including shooting jacket, sling, glove, hat and ear defenders. All these items (except hats) will be provided if you don't have them. If you possess your own Target Rifle or can borrow and bring the one that you usually use with your club, you should bring it with you.

FOOD AND BEVERAGE

Tea and coffee will be available during the classroom sessions of the course at no extra charge. Lunch will be provided in one of the Bisley Clubs.
