NRA TARGET RIFLE SKILLS DEVELOPMENT COURSE

SATURDAY 27th & SUNDAY 28th April 2019

AIM

The Target Rifle (TR) Advanced Skills Development Course is aimed at those who are already in possession of a Target Rifle and wish to develop their skills, improve their scores and take part in TR events and competitions. The course will include individual coaching on shooting position and technique, zeroing, plotting as an aid to group centring, wind reading, coping with wet weather and the essentials of competition and team shooting.

The course is open to all NRA members who have a Shooter Certification Card (SCC) and sufficient TR experience to shoot unsupervised, including those who do not currently hold an FAC or possess a Target Rifle. Non-NRA members can attend providing they possess an (SCC) and pay the additional non-membership fee.

The course is held over two days and will involve both classroom and practical range work.

This course is being run in conjunction with the Bisley clubs and the location for the course will be the Webley Room, NRA Pavilion on Bisley Camp.

COURSE FEE

The course fee is £120.00 (£72.00 for Under 25s) which includes range fees, markers, plot diagrams, individual coaching and lunches.

Ammunition and rifles are not included. Where possible, attendees should bring the rifle they usually use. If not yet in possession of a suitable target rifle, attendees can have use of an NRA rifle for £34.00 for two days (50% discount), and purchase ammunition (48 rds of 7.62mm at a cost of £43.50) both will be issued on the range.

CANCELLATION FEE

Courses cancelled within 5 working days of course date will be subject to a cancellation fee of £20.00.

DRESS AND EQUIPMENT

Attendees should wear their usual shooting clothing, with under layers according to the weather. Footwear suitable for soggy ranges and waterproofs should also be brought. Attendees should bring the shooting gear they usually use, including shooting jacket, sling, glove, hat and ear defenders. Please note shooters wishing to wear camouflage are not permitted to wear full camouflage (i.e jacket and trousers).

FOOD AND BEVERAGE

Tea and coffee will be available during the classroom sessions of the course at no extra charge. Lunch will be provided in the London & Middlesex Rifle Association Clubhouse.

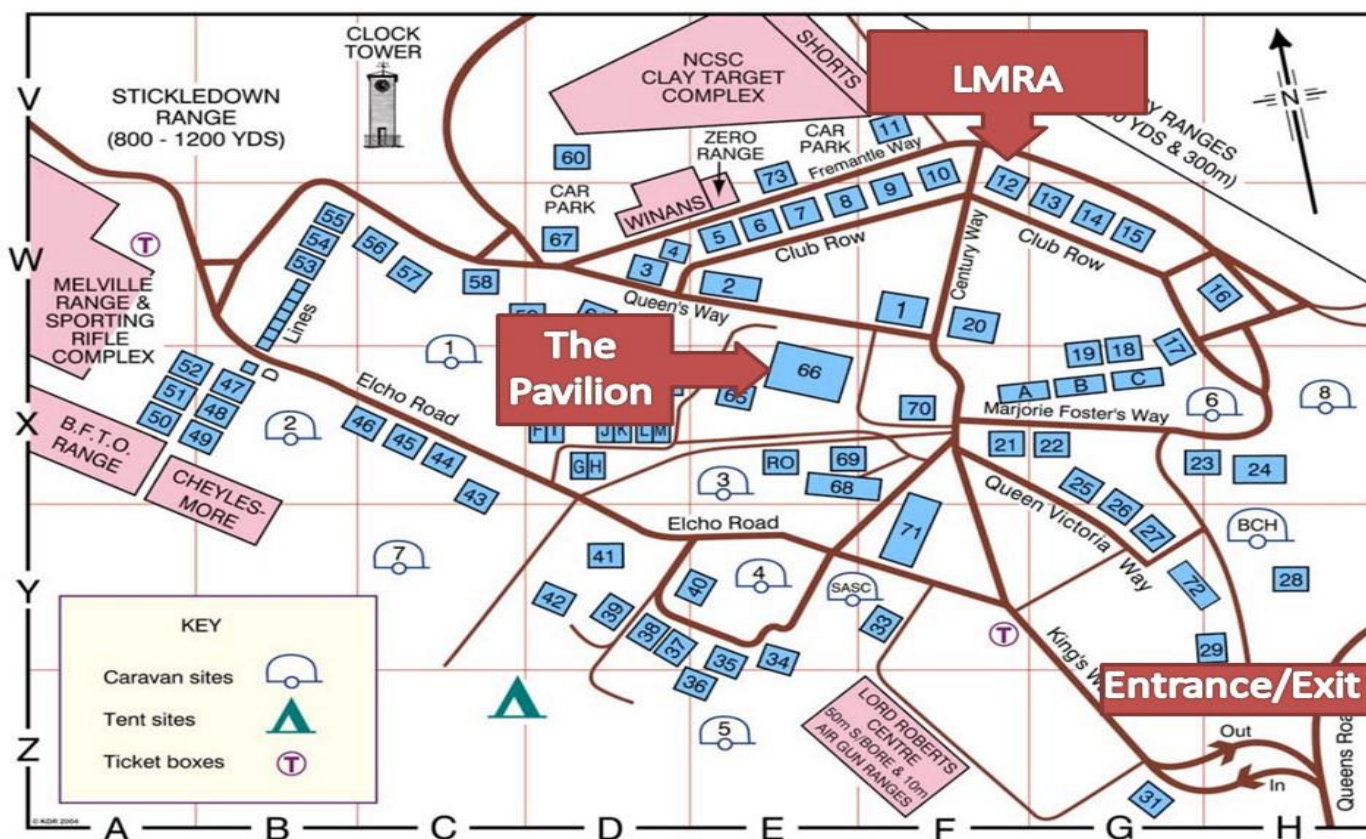
