<b>Permitted firearms and ammunition including ME &amp; MV</b>	<p><b>Type:</b> Rifles and Pistols (including in both cases airguns)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Maximum Muzzle Velocity:</b> 655 m/s (2150 ft/s)</li> <li>• <b>Maximum Muzzle Energy:</b> 2030 J (1496 ft lb)</li> </ul> <p><b>Type:</b> Shotguns</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 12 -32 bore (including .410 bore)</li> <li>• Hard targets: No4 or smaller shot</li> <li>• Frangible targets: SG or smaller shot</li> </ul> <p><b>Not Permitted:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 22 Hornet</li> <li>• .17 HMR</li> <li>• 300 Blackout</li> <li>• 300 Whisper</li> </ul> <p><b>Special Requirements:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Air guns</li> <li>• Slug: subject to the constraints described below and must be notified at the time of the booking.</li> </ul>
<b>RANGE SAFETY LIMITATIONS</b>	
<b>Coordinating Instructions</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Shooting on this range has no effect on any other ranges.</li> <li>2. A Suitably Qualified Experienced Person (SQEP) is to be appointed as the responsible RO when shooting on Bay A.</li> </ol> <p><b>Rifles and Pistols</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>3. Maximum of 8 lanes.               <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Special requirements for NRA competitions.</li> </ol> </li> </ol> <p><b>Shotguns</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>4. Slug               <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Maximum 4 lanes. 1 x firer within each section.</li> </ol> </li> <li>5. Shot size No4 – SG               <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Maximum 3 lanes. 1 x firer on 3 LH sections.</li> </ol> </li> </ol> <p><b>Firearm Combination</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>6. Sitting</li> <li>ii. Kneeling</li> <li>iii. Standing</li> <li>iv. Benched</li> <li>v. Engagement distance: 20m only</li> </ul> </li> <li>b. Shot size No4 – SG same as Pistols</li> <li>c. Shot size No5 or smaller shot <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. Sitting</li> <li>ii. Kneeling</li> <li>iii. Standing</li> <li>iv. Benched</li> <li>v. Minimum engagement distance: 7m.</li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p>10. Changes of position are permitted within any detail or practice providing all firers follow the same sequence.</p> <p>11. Fire and movement (i.e. changing location during a detail with a loaded firearm) is permitted with shotguns, only if:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. The movement area is clearly delineated by objects or markers that do not constitute a trip hazard</li> <li>b. No movement up range is involved</li> <li>c. Only one firer is on the range at a time</li> </ul> <p>12. During practical shooting when shooting through an aperture, the muzzle of the firearm is to protrude completely through the aperture.</p>
<p><b>Targetry</b></p>	<p>13. <b>MAX TCH:</b> 1.5m</p> <p>14. Ricochet inducing material used to construct practical courses of fire is to be fully protected sufficiently to prevent ricochet.</p> <p>15. <b>Hard Targets:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Permission to shoot at hard targets is to be requested in the Range Office</li> <li>b. Minimum engagement distance is 10m for LV and 22m for HV.</li> </ul> <p>16. <b>Rifle and Pistols</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Penetrable Targets only</li> </ul> <p>17. <b>Shotguns</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Slug: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. Hard targets not permitted</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>b. Shot size No4 – SG                             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. Hard targets not permitted</li> </ul> </li> <li>c. Shot size No4 or smaller                             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. Hard targets are permitted</li> <li>ii. Hard targets to be placed within area defined by red marker on the bullet catcher defence wall.</li> <li>iii. Hard targets to be placed no more than 1m up range from the bullet catcher defence wall</li> <li>iv. Hard targets are to be placed so not to damage range infrastructure</li> <li>v. Spikes and posts are not to be driven in to the range floor</li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p>18. Unless prior permission has been obtained from the CE only targets from the NRA approved set may be used.</p> <p>19. Targets are to be used in the frames or holders provided and are to be engaged only from the recognised firing points and /or appropriate shooting station or peg. Any deviation from this is to be notified, in writing, and approved by the Head of Range Services.</p> <p>20. Clay pigeons are not to be engaged within Winans Range</p>
