In the NRA Council Minutes of 26 April 1871 the Rules for the Match resolved that "the minimum number of competitors in each team will be eight". In addition the Minute stated that "the Team representing the Mother Country shall be regulated as to number by that of the smallest Indian or Colonial teams and that the teams shall be the highest scores in the International Trophy Match of that year".

The Bombay Rifle Association requested permission to shoot in the Match on their own range as "they could not get to Wimbledon". Not surprisingly the NRA Council refused permission!

The Demerara Rifle Association (West Indies) also intended to compete but eventually were not able to get to England.

Coaching was allowed from within the firers and Team Officers. Coaches were not awarded badges until 1929 and Reserves probably from 1912. Coaches were not allowed until 1879 and then coaches had to be eligible to shoot for the team they coached until 1931. From 1932 outside coaches were allowed.

200 yards was fired standing and 500 and 600 yards prone.

Seven counting shots at each distance with a Bull scoring only 4 points.

Maximum possible score per firer was 84 points.

Rifles: Three-groove long Snider of bona fide Government pattern, bearing Government Viewer's Mark.

The Mother Country Team was in fact called The United Team from the Mother Country. In future years it was just called the Mother Country.

In 1873 the NRA Council amended the original rules to permit only teams of 8 firers restricted to:

- 1 One squad of efficient Volunteers from the Mother Country
- 2 One squad of efficient Volunteers from India
- 3 One squad from Colonial Militia (or efficient Volunteers) from any British colony
- 4 One squad of members of the Indian Civil Service home on leave

The squad from the Mother Country shall consist of eight men who have shot in the International Trophy Match for the current year, chosen as follows: *Two men from the nationality making the lowest score in the International Trophy Match, and three from each of the others; in the event of those men who make the best shooting in their respective Squads being unable or unwilling to shoot, the next in order will be taken.*

Once again the Match conditions were changed in order to facilitate the admission of an Indian Squad. In 1873 the squad was described as: *"to consist of Members of the Indian Civil Service home on leave"*.

It having been represented to the NRA Council that under this condition the field of selection became so limited as to make it all but impossible to form a squad, they amended it as follows: *"One squad composed of members, home on leave, of the Indian Staff Corps, or of Indian Volunteers, or of persons who are bonâ fide members of an Indian Rifle Association in connection with the NRA, and who have competed in India at Annual Meetings"*.

In 1874 the value of the Bull was increased to 5 points and therefore the HPS of the individual became 105 points
